Sub: Constitution of Committee to review the compliance by CETP's

Ref: Proceedings of the review meeting held through Video Conference on 03.07.2020 and the proceedings vide no. 1232 dt: 14.07.2020

There are 11 Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETP's) operating in the State of Karnataka, with a total treatment capacity of 7715 KLD. These CETP's are meant for treating the effluent generated from small scale industries. However, large and medium scale industries are also disposing their trade effluent to CETP. In case of large scale industries, Hon'ble NGT has issued a directions to have their own ETP for treating the trade effluent generated from their respective industries.

Further, these CETP's are regularly being monitored by KSPCB through physical inspections, analysis of treated water sample collected during the inspection and also through OCEMS data of CETP. However, there are incidences of illegal discharge, at times, by either CETP authorities or by the transporter who collects and transport the trade effluent from different industries to CETP. Hence there is a need for effective implementation of monitoring mechanism (centralized monitoring system at KSPCB) in tracking vehicles carrying effluent from different industries and also to use modern technology available for monitoring the quality of effluent.

In this regard, a meeting was held, through Video Conferencing on 03.07.2020 to review the functioning of CETP's and the compliance status, wherein a detailed deliberation was made on the problems faced by CETP's, various directions were given by different authorities from time to time etc., wherein a decision was taken to constitute a committee to review the compliance made by CETP's and to suggest modification in O& M of CETP's, transportation monitoring system, working status of OCEMS installed in CETP's and to explore the possibility of establishing one more CETP in Karnataka.

Hence, the Committee consisting of following members is constituted

The Committee shall work with the following terms of reference

- 1. To review the compliance made by CETP's to the proceedings of the meeting held on 28.08.2019.
- 2. To review the compliance to CPCB directions from time to time.
- 3. To make suggestions for each CETP, based on the performance evaluations and to improve the O &M.
- Evaluation of working status of OCEMS installed at CETP's.
- 5. To explore the possibilities of establishment of one more new CETP in Karnataka.
- 6. To make specific recommendations for improvement in Statutory Compliance by CETP's and to check/ prevent any illegal discharge.
- 7. To recommend modern software technology to track the vehicular movement and to use in built sensors for different CETP's, specific pollutant parameters for effective monitoring of CETP's.
- 8. To explore the possibility of fixing of jurisdiction for each CETP.
- 9. The term of the Committee shall be for a period of one year from the date of issue of this OM.

The Regional Officers/ RSEO's shall submit a detailed report of CETP's (of their jurisdiction) to the Committee along with the referral rate to be fixed per KL of trade effluent collected from the industries and treated at CETP's.
