Proceedings of the Review Meeting on Implementation of C & D Waste Management Rules, 2016 under the Chairmanship of The Justice Subhash B. Adi Chairperson NGT-SLC on 12-02-2021 in 3rd floor , KSPCB, Church Street, Bengaluru.

Preamble

In continuation of the meeting held on 08-02-2021 regarding implementation of the C & D waste management Rules, 2016, one more meeting was called on 12-02-2021 involving D.M.A., CPWD, BMRCL, Gram panchayats P.D.O.'s of Devanahalli Taluk E.O's. of Taluk panchayats, Yelahanka and Devanahalli Taluks, BIAL, Bangalore Smart City Limited, & BWSSB.

Mr. Yathish, SEO WMC, KSPCB, Board office welcomed all participants and briefed on the agenda of the meeting and gave brief background of the meeting held on 08-02-2021.

H'onble Justice Subhash B. Adi, Chair person, NGT-SLC, who chaired the meeting directed all participants to introduce themselves.

At the outset the Chairman, NGT-SLC expressed his displeasure over slow progress in implementation of above Rules by various generators and local bodies. The Chairman specifically enquired with BWSSB on management made for C & D waste management and disposal and also about the submission of Waste Management Plan as required U/R 4 of the C & D waste management Rules.

BWSSB representative submitted, provisions have been made in contract agreement for disposal of C & D waste generated during course of executing the work.

The Chairman brought to the notice of the BWSSB Officer as to the duties and responsibilities as the generator of C & D waste as per the Rule 4 and to have co-ordination with other service provider bodies like BESCOM, BBMP etc. for proper disposal of the C & D waste and directed



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the BWSSB official to submit the waste management plan as per the rules for the existing and proposed projects within one month to the B.B.M.P. and to obtain approval with a copy to the office of NGT-SLC.

Mr. Yathish SEO, KSPCB submitted that, C & D Rules, 2016 is available in the Board website KSPCB.Gov.IN and as well as KSPCB mobile APP and anybody can download the same.

The Chairman, NGT SLC highlighted provisions of Rule 4 & Rule 5 of the C & D Rules and reminded that any generator, who generates 20 TPD of C & D waste per day or 300 TPM of waste per project or in a month, who are required to prepare waste management plan and submit to the concerned local body for approval and to proceed further only after obtaining the approval. Even in case of construction, no construction plan be sanctioned unless the plan for C & D waste disposal plan is approved. BWSSB representative replied that at present they do not have any major works in core area of the city and works are going on in 110 villages limits and C & D waste is being transported outside the Bangalore city and disposed of at their treatment plants premises. The Chairman, directed the authority to dispose of C & D waste at to B.B.M.P. designated plants that is at two places namely Chikkajala and Kannur and to clear off debris left by at any construction place within a month.

Representative of M/s. Rock crystal, C & D waste operator, Blore submitted that, in most cases, contractors are disposing C & D waste as per their convenience and due to which, it is not possible to ascertain as to which generator is actually bringing the waste and how much of waste is being disposed against their waste management plan.

The Chairman brought to the notice of the Executive Officer, Taluk panchayath, Devanahalli, regarding on going heavy construction works by BIAL and the application filled by the pending BIAL are with four Gram Panchayaths, i.e two in Devanahalli Taluk and two in Yelahanka Taluk without being considered for approval. Further directed the EO Taluk Panchayat to take steps for immediate disposal of the pending applications of BIAL. The Executive Officer, Devanahally Taluk Panchayath requested for conducting awareness program on C & D Rules to their P.D.O's.

The Chairman, NGT-SLC directed the KSPCB to arrange a training programme on C & D Rules for P.D.O's of Bengaluru (U) & Bengaluru (R) Gram Panchayaths, Town Panchayats, Town Municipalities and city municipalities.

The representative of C.P.W.D. submitted that, they are involved in eight construction works in Bengaluru and generating 2 T to 5T C & D waste per each project per day. Further said they will pay the processing and transportation fee to the local authority and follow the Rules. Also, stated that, they are re-using demolished material for construction.

The Chairman directed the representative of the slum clearance Board to strictly follow the C & D Rules and to submit the approved waste management plan with in a month to the concerned local bodies as per the C & D Rules. Director, DMA stated that six out of ten city corporation have identified the sites for C & D processing and they are at various stages of establishment like D.P.R. publication of Rules, publishing of Bye- laws etc. Also,are expecting Central Government Funds for these establishments. The Chairman directed the DMA to take steps to create awareness of C & D Rules to the concerned authorities of all local bodies regarding selection of operator and also regarding user fee etc.

The Chairman took serious note of no representation from Railways and BMRCL to the meeting inspite of sending the meeting notice. Also directed to record that, KUIDFC, which is a nodal/authority for all smart city projects to co-ordinate with Managing Directors of smart cities for preparation of waste management plan and to submit the same for approval within a month to the concerned local body /authority as per rules.

Director, DMA further stated that, they are proposing to establish regional waste disposal facilities combining 3 to 4 districts and co-ordination of the local bodies coming their under would be worked for proper disposal of the C & D waste as per C & D rules. The Chairman NGT-SLC also directed the Director, DMA to immediately issue remainder to all local bodies to strictly implement the plastic wastes management Rules, 2016 and to inform that Chairman NGT-SLC will be making a visit shortly. Based on the above meeting following directions are issued by the Chairman, NGT, SLC.

- (1) All the service providers like BWSSB, BESCOM, PWD, CPWD, etc shall submit their waste management plan within one month to their respective local bodies with a copy marked to NGT, SLC.
- (2) D.M.A. shall immediately identify operators of C & D facilities on BOOT basis and publish the same as per the C & D Rules provisions and fix the user charges.
- (3) KSPCB to arrange for awareness programme an C & D waste Rules, 2016 to all P.D.O's and the officers of other local bodies of Bengaluru (U) & Bengaluru (R) Districts, including other service providers like BWSSB, BESCOM etc.



- (4) Executive Officers of Devanahalli & Chikkajala Taluk Panchayaths shall ensure that, application filed by BIAL under C & D Rules Acts is disposed of at the earliest.
- (5) KUIDFC shall ensure that, all the smart I city projects Managing Directors shall prepare and submit the C & D waste management plan to the respective local bodies within 30 days and a copy of the same shall be submitted to the NGT-SLC for record purpose.
- (6) D.M.A. to issue directions to all local bodies to ensure the strict implementation of PMW Rules, 2016 and to submit a copy of such direction to NGT-SLC.]
- (7)M/s. Rock crystals shall immediately submit report on amount of C & D waste received from various service providers against the waste management plans approved and details of disposal and re- use in compliance with the C & D rules.

The meeting ended with thanks to the Chair.
