OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub.: Applicability of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 with respect to Stone Crushing Units-reg.,

Ref.: 1. CPCB Direction dated 07.03.2016, Notification No. 1232 dated 14.07.2016

The CPCB during 2016 has issued a direction to all SPCB's categorizing the industrial activities into Red, Orange, Green & White based on the pollution potential, wherein the Stone Crusher and/ M-Sand are considered under Orange Category at Sl. No. 64(Original No. 73) after giving proper weightage as per the procedure laid down by CPCB. It is observed that there is no uniformity in granting of consent of the Board(few apply only under Air Act and others under both Acts). Hence there is requirement of giving clarification.


A note was submitted by SEO, Mines and Stone Crusher section wherein, it indicates that

As per the Section 25(1) of Water(Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, no person shall, without the previous consent of the Board:

- Establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process, or any treatment & disposal system are or any extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or sewer or on land (such discharge being hereafter in this section referred to as discharge of sewage); or
- Bring into use any new or altered outlet for the discharge of sewage; or
- Begin to make any new discharge of sewage.

Stone crusher requires manpower to operate, there by generation of sewage

In view of the above stone crushing activity shall be covered under Water Act.
