PROCEEDINGS OF THE ONLINE REVIEW MEETING CONDUCTED THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCE WITH COMMISSIONERS OF CMC's BY HON'BLE JUSTICE SRI.SUBHASH.B.ADI THE CHAIRMAN, NGT, SLC TO REVIEW COMPLIANCE AS PER DIRECTIONS UNDER THE NGT OA NO 606/2018 HELD ON 20.01.2021 WEDNESDAY AT 11.00 AM AT 3rd FLOOR,KARNATAKA STATE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD, PARISARA BHAVAN, CHURCH STREET.

The State Level Committee for monitoring the implementation of SWM Rules, 2016 in Karnataka was constituted by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi in case no. O.A.No.606/2018 and in furtherance of the same regularly review of the progress made on compliance by the concerned departments and local bodies were conducted. In continuation of the same, an online meeting was convened on 20.01.2021 under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chairman, NGT, SLC to review the progress made so far in compliance of SWM Rules by all CMC's in the state with regard to implementation of SWM Rules, 2016, C&D Rules, 2016, BMW Rules, 2016, PWM Rules,2016 and Hon'ble NGT directions given in the OA No.606/2018.

The meeting was chaired by the Hon'ble Justice Subhash. B. Adi, Chairman, NGT-SLC, Karnataka. The list of participants is as per the **Annexure-I**.

Sri. Srinivasalu, IFS, Member Secretary, Karnataka State Pollution Control Board and Member Convener of the above Committee welcomed the Chairman and other officers to the meeting and gave brief background of agenda for the meeting and recent developments and High court directions and seriousness of the issues as well as for initiation of action against the violating CMC. Commissioners of CMC's and Chief Officers of Town Municipal Council (TMC). The Commissioners and representatives of CMC and TMC were present in the Video Conference.

In the beginning the Chairman, NGT, SLC called the Commissioner, Chikkaballapur to state about compliance to above Rules and directions. In reply, the Commissioner, CMC stated that 100% segregation has been achieved in 31 wards, and waste is being processed using windrow
