CIRCULAR

Sub: Stipulating capacity for the used barrel recyclers -reg.

Under the Hazardous and Other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 notified by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climatic Change, the quantities of hazardous waste are required to be expressed in terms of weight. The Board is stipulating nos. for certain categories of like used barrels. Some of the units are giving the quantities by weight others by numbers. Hence, there is a necessity to streamline the quantities indicated in the consent and authorization to enable the Board to properly estimate the waste barrels disposed by the generator. The Board while submitting annual returns for the period 2016-17 and 2017-18 has considered an average of 7 kg/used barrels. This can be followed until any alternative methods are available. While verifying both the weight and numbers shall be considered by the inspecting officers.

For the purpose of granting consent following formula is consider.

1. Number of barrels considered for cleaning /hour = 4
2. Number of working hours (2 shifts) = 16
3. Number of barrels that can be cleaned /day = 64
4. Weight of barrels that can be cleaned/day = 448 kg

The above is for 1 bay cleaning, if the industry has area and facility for 2 bay cleaning, then the capacity is 128 nos/896 kgs.

All the regional officers are instructed to follow the circular.
