NOTIFICATION

Sub: Empanelment of Environmental Auditors as per Amendment to the Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 Dated: 23.11.2016 for the purpose of verifying the facts and issue Certificate of “No increase in Pollution Load” –reg.

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Preamble: The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India has issued amendment to the Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 vide ref. (1) in respect of exempting existing units which propose to undertake modernisation, change in product mix in the existing plants having prior Environmental Clearance, if there is no additional pollution load beyond the earlier approved limit is envisaged. In the said Notification, procedure has been laid down to deal with such cases involving change in product mix without change in quantity and pollution load as prescribed in the Environmental clearance obtained earlier.

In this regard, the Board has empanelled 7 auditors as per the procedure laid down in the Notification cited at ref.(1) and issued notification vide ref. (2) with conditions for a period of one year. As per the Notification cited at ref. (2), the Board is required the review performance of the empanelled auditors once in a year. So far, 6 industries have submitted applications under this notification through 3 empanelled auditors. Since the remaining 4 empanelled auditors have not presented any proposal on no increase in pollution load before the Technical Committee, review of performance of all the 7 empanelled auditors could not be taken up. The above issue was deliberated in the 1st reconstituted Technical Committee Meeting held on 09.09.2020 as per EIA Notification cited at ref. (1). Committee after detailed deliberation has recommended to extend empanelment period for a further period of six months i.e., up to 31.03.2021 and take-up review thereafter. The Technical Committee also deliberated on fresh application filed for the purpose of empanelment and recommended to empanel for a period of Six month and take up for review after six months along with other 7 empanelled auditors.

Further, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide amendment to the EIA Notification, 2006 cited at ref.(3) has exempted requirement of obtaining prior environmental clearance in respect of project having prior Environmental Clearance and intend to take up “any change in raw material- mix or product mix, change in quantities within products or number of products in the same category for which prior environmental clearance has been granted provided there is no increase in pollution load and the resultant increase in production is not more than 50 % of the production capacity permitted in the earlier prior environmental clearance and

the project proponent shall follow the procedure of obtaining " No increase in Pollution load' Certificate laid down in 23.11.2016 amendment cited at ref.(1).

In view of the facts stated above, the Board hereby extend the validity of empanelled auditor indicated at Sl. No. (1) to (7) of the following table up to 31/3/2021 and also empanel new agency indicated at Sl. (8) as empanelled auditor upto 31/3/2021 for the purpose of technical evaluation of the proposal submitted by the industry and to issue " No increase in Pollution Load Certificate" as per the Notification cited at ref. (1) and (3) only with following terms and conditions;
