**Sub.:** Review of status of solid Waste management by Yelahanka and Dasarahalli zone of  
Bengaluru Bruhath Mahanagara Palike (BBMP)

July 2021 and 13 September 2021.

**Preamble:**

In exercise of Power conferred under the provision of Environment Protection Act 1986 the central Government notified the Solid Waste Management Rules 2016 (SWM Rules) under which time schedule was prescribed for compliance of SWM Rules by all the local bodies of respective state and union territory. Despite of constitution of National level, Regional level, state level monitoring committee for effective compliance of the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in PIL, did not much progress was achieved. Thus the Hon'ble Supreme court found it appropriate that the matter could be better monitored by the special tribunal constituted that is "National Green Tribunal" (NGT) which is an exclusive authority for protection of environment. According the pending PIL was transferred to NGT which came to be numbered as O.A. 6060/2018.

It is in pursuance of the reference made by the Supreme Court, the NGT offer series of hearing and monitoring felt it necessary to constitute state level committee for effective implementation of the SWM Rules by respective States as well as Union territories. Accordingly NGT by its order dated 16<sup>th</sup> January 2019 in O.A. 606/2018 constituted State Level Committee for respective States headed by former Judge of the High Court and directed State Level Committee to effectively monitor the implementation of SWM Rules in their respective States and also directed to convene the first meeting of the committee on or before 15 February 2019.

The State government in pursuance of the order of NGT referred to above issued notification dated 13<sup>th</sup> February 2019 constituted state level committee in compliance of the direction of the NGT. The first meet of state level monitoring committee was convened 14<sup>th</sup> February

2019. Since then the state level committee has been reviewing and monitoring the implementation of SWM rules in Karnataka by conducting periodical review meeting and inspection. However due to pandemic COVID - 19 during 2020 and 2021 very few review meetings were held by observing all parameter of Covid-19.

As per the data available the state of Karnataka generates more the 11 tonnes of Solid Waste per day out of which nearly 5000 MT of Solid Waste per day is generated by BBMP, having regard to the voluminous Solid Waste generated by BBMP and also having regard to receipt of several complaints, State Level Committee felt it necessary to have regular review of status of solid waste management by BBMP.

### Proceedings:

In order to have a effectively review and take appropriate steps to ensure compliance with SWM Rules by the BBMP, meetings were conducted zonal wise i.e., two zone out of eight zones of BBMP were taken each time. Accordingly in respect of two zones Yelahanka and Dasarahalli the review meeting was held on 9-3-2022. The said review meeting was attended by the Chairman and following officials.
