Terms of Reference (TOR) for Technical Advisory Committee.

- a. To scrutinize the EIA Reports, proposals of pollution control measures/ technologies submitted by the industries and referred to the committee.
The subjects/matters referred to the committee should be
 - Only subjects dealing with new process and technologies
 - Complex processes including emissions and effluents
 - Matters for imposing stringent standards or for evolving new standards
 - Technical scrutiny of treatment options
 - For other specific advise required for which no expertise is available in the Board
 - Any other technical subject on which specific advice is sought
- b. To recommend suitable pollution control measures to be adopted by the specific industries/organizations.
- c. Scrutiny of R & D proposals on which specific advice is sought.
- d. For reasons to be recorded, Chairman of the TAC may recommend the Member Convener to invite any subject experts/specialists to the TAC meeting whenever such subjects are to be discussed.
- e. Any other task assigned by the Board/Chairman.
- f. The Members of the committee other than the officers of the Board are entitled for sitting fee and other allowances as per the Board norms.
- g. *The tenure of the committee is for the period of one year from the date of publication of this Office Memorandum.*

Note: All the decisions of TAC are recommendatory in nature.
