No. 606/2018) on dt. 22.7.2021 and 13.09.2021

Preamble :

In furtherance of direction issued by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) for implementation and compliance of the Solid Waste Management (SWM) Rules, 2016 several meetings were held with local bodies more particularly in respect of (BBMP).

BBMP is large contributor of Municipal Solid Waste in State and is also required to comply with the SWM Rules, 2016 within the time schedule. Under the SWM Rules every local body needs to comply and implement the rules within a period of three years from the date of notification of the said rules, however the said period has expired long back. It is under the supervision of NGT time is extended at the request of the state. On the assurance by state that it would comply with SWM rules with in reasonable times.

In order to achieve 100% compliance of SWM Rules, several meeting were held with the BBMP authorities for reviewing the progress made which includes Construction and Demolition (C&D) waste management, plastic waste management, Bio-Medical Waste (BMW) management, e-waste management, Hazardous waste management etc. Having

regard to the non-compliance as well as to the seriousness of the consequence of non-compliance, a meeting was convened on 22.07.2021 with following agenda to ensure the timely compliance of SWM Rules.

Agenda 1 Compliance to directions issued in meeting held on 18.12.2020

Agenda 2 Compliance to directions issued in meeting held on 20.01.2021

Agenda 3 Review of compliance to The Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016

In above 1st meeting concerned officials were directed to submit plan of action for compliance within 15 days from date of receipt of copy of these proceedings, for which, the officers present in the said meeting agreed to comply with in time limit.

However none of the officials of BBMP submitted compliance report. Hence, another meeting was convened on 13.09.2021, but for the said meeting also except superintendent engineer and processing plant manager none of the other concerned official attended.

Since, despite several meetings and direction, BBMP did not show any requisite progress in compliance with SWM Rules. Hence, once again the following suggestions were made on 13.07.2021 for the observation and compliance by BBMP in consensus with SWM Rules:

- Formulate micro planning and implementation in BBMP area
- Formulate micro level committees for overseeing solid waste management
- Rank each ward based on compliance of Rule 4 and 15 of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016
- Submit action taken report against non-performer with respect to Rule 4 of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016
- Submit details of user fee collected by BBMP as per the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016
- All Regional Officer of Karnataka State Pollution Control Board (KSPCB) who has jurisdiction within BBMP area to submit report on compliance to Rule 15 of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 by BBMP
- Identify black spots
- Randomly check compliance to rule 4 and other provisions of the Waste Management Rules, 2016 by bulk waste generators, gated community and others
