Puranik., Environmental Officer, KSPCB, Bagalkote extended a warm welcome to the Additional Deputy Commissioner & Chairman, Environmental Public Hearing Committee, Bagalkote District, the Senior Environmental Officer, KSPCB, Dharwad and all the surrounding villagers & public, elected representatives and members and the Staff of the Mining Company who were present in the hearing. Further, he briefly explained the needs for Environmental Clearance for the said Mining project are as follows:

M/s. Ssha Sai Limestone, Muddapur possess a Mining Lease bearing No.2523 to Mine Limestone & Dolomite in survey No.95 (Part), revenue land in Yandigeri Village, Badami Taluk Bagalkot Dist., Karnataka State over an extent of 4.86HA.

As per the Notification issued by the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India on 14.09.2006 (Amendment Notification on 01-12-2009), it is a prerequisite to get Environmental Clearance from the SEIAA, GOK and Conducting Environmental Public Hearing.

As per the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee, Government of Karnataka, Terms of Reference Letter dated: 08-10-2020 and the concurrence of The Deputy Commissioner Bagalkote, the Public Hearing is scheduled on 18-11-2020 at the Project Site.

As per the EIA Notification, the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board gave the Paper Notification 30 days in advance in the Kannada Daily Newspaper "Hosa Diganta" and English Daily Newspaper "Times of India" dated: 17-10-2020 and in local daily Kannada Newspaper "Sanje Darshan" on 20-10-2020.
